Indians will give native songs and dances, and the French visitors will respond with some of the old chansons that were brought to this continent 300 years ago.

The Indians who will take part in the production are descendants of the tribe whom Brule and Grenelle found at Pawling, and, in fact, it was only in 1805 that the Indian village on Whitefish Island, in the St. Mary's Rapids, in the city limits, was abandoned.

Hiawatha will be assumed by a young Ojibway named Zach, twenty-one years old, who comes of a very old Indian family.

Shawano, an Ojibway, about forty years old, presents the character of Sagoyewew, the story teller. Shawano is a great athlete, and it is of record that no white man has yet been able to put him out of canoe in tilting contests.

Kwasind, the strong man, who aids Hiawatha to clear the river of rocks and trees in the poem, will be represented by an Ojibway named Mukwa (the bear), who is quite a good actor.

The part of Chibabow, the sweet singer, will be taken by Tatababundung, the best tenor singer of the Ojibways. The lyric singing of old Indian songs will be one of the features of the play.

And the people from the margin watched him floating, rising, sinking. Till the birch canoe seemed lifted high into the sea of splendor. Till it sank into the vapors. Like the new moon slowly, slowly sinking in the purple distance.

Thus departed Hiawatha, Hiawatha in the helms, the sweet singer, in the glow of the sunset, in the purple mist of evening. To the region of the home-land, Of the northwest wind Keewaydin, To the Islands of the Blessed, To the kingdom of Ponemah. To the land of the Hereafter.
