GASOLINE A MINOR ITEM OF AUTO COST
Advance of One Cent a Gallon Means Only 5 Cents to the Owner, Standard Oil Co. Says.

An advance of one cent a gallon in the price of gasoline means an increase of only 85 annually in the cost of operating an automobile, according to the Standard Oil Company of New Jersey. The company points out that "at the highest price at which I ever sold, gasoline was one of the most items of expense in the operation of a motor car."

According to a comparison in the current issue of The Lat, the motorist spends 11.38 cents for his gasoline and grease out of every dollar he spends on the car on the road. The charges are as follows:

Oil and grease 11.32c
Tires 10.42c
Depreciation 10.38c
Miscellaneous 20.65c
Repairs 42.17c
100.00

In the matter of transportation the fundamental requirement of any agency is motive power, supplied for the most part by fuel. In this connection the cost of power costs last year was a relatively small proportion of the total cost of the car. The Interborough Rapid Transit Company itself showed 20.43 per cent of its total operating expenses was for power, cost alone representing 75 per cent of this, or 15.7 per cent.

"Nearly every owner of a car," it is stated, "takes it for granted that his largest item of expense after buying his car is for fuel consumed. The explanation of that lies in the fact that he puts his hand into his pocket to pay the man at the pump several times as often as he does for other expenses of driving. On a touring trip of several days the owner may buy gasoline and an occasional quart of oil a dozen times and pay nothing else for his car except for garage space over night. But on that trip depreciation is going steadily on, tires are wearing away and the car is getting nearer to necessary repairs. These items, when met, are usually larger than the combined total of many weeks' expenditures for gasoline."

POLAND GOES IN FOR VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS
Modernizing the Course—No Longer to Be All Classical.
