Daily Hints For the Cook

GRAN BERRY PUDDING

Cream one cup, sugar with three teaspoons of butter, add slowly one cup sweet milk, two cups flour, sifted with two teaspoons of cream of tartar and one teaspoon of baking powder.

SALAD DRESSING

Heat half cup vinegar in double boiler. Mix two level teaspoons mustard and two level teaspoons salt, three level tablespoons sugar, quarter teaspoon paprika or little less of cayenne. I prefer the latter. Add three eggs (I use two when high), beat, then add one cup thick cream and beat with egg beater.
