Daily Hints For the Cook. Rice Cakes. Half pound rice, 1-2 pound flour, 1-2 pound sugar, 2 eggs, 2 teaspoons baking powder, 1-4 pound butter, essence of onion to taste.

Spanish Rice. Right to 10 slices of bacon fried until brown and crisp, one onion sliced and put in same pan with bacon. Fry a golden brown. Add two cups cold boiled rice and one can of peas and mix thoroughly with the onion and bacon, breaking the bacon into small pieces. Heat thoroughly and serve at once. One use tomatoes if liked, instead of the peas.
