FIRST CHARGE

"When on Active Service", absenting himself without leave," in that he, at CHIPSTEAD, Surrey, on 3 Nov 41, did absent himself without leave from 2230 hrs., 3 Nov 41, until 1000 hrs., 5 Nov 41." (Time Absent 1 day 112 hrs)

SECOND CHARGE "When on Active Service Breaking out of billets," in that he, at CHIPSTEAD, Surrey, on 5 Nov 41, did break out ARMY ACT of billets while under open arrest."

THIRD CHARGE

"When on Active Service Absenting himself without leave," in that he, at CHIPSTEAD, Surrey, on 5 Nov 41, did absent himself without leave from 2000 hrs., 5 Nov 41, until 0100 hrs., 6 Nov 41." (Time Absent 5 hrs)
