FIRST EDITION. DOTTING THE PRAIRIE. BLUECOATS MARCH TO HEAD OFF AN INDIAN TROUPE.

A Large Body of Troops to be Massed at Roswell and Pine Ridge agencies. Which Will Doubtless Have a Quiet-Down Effect. Breaks on His Way to Take Command.

Low's Party, Nov. 18.—Troops have been pouring into Roswell all day and to-night. The steady prairie, stretching away between that point and Pine Ridge agency, is dotted with troops, who are making a forced march to Indian strong-holds.

One interesting feature of the present situation will be the arrival in Roswell tonight of Buffalo Bill's troops of the Sioux who have just returned from a two years' tour of Europe.

It is reported here that the Indians at Pine Ridge agency are still dancing and growing daily more sullen. Old Red Cloud has made repeated efforts to check the fanaticism of the young men, but he has at last been compelled to leave his people to their fate.

The soldiers now marching on the agency will not pass at any one point. It is probable that six companies will go into camp at Pine Ridge, the rest will be stationed within easy call.
