

# THE PRINCE AND PRINCESS OF WALES

STARTED TO DAY ON  
THEIR TOUR OF INDIA

Royal Party Will Travel Overland to  
Genoa and Will Embark on

London, Oct. 19.—The Prince and Princess of Wales started on their six months tour of India to-day. King Edward, Queen Alexandra, the other members of the royal family and the cabinet ministers bid them farewell at the railroad station.

The Prince and Princess of Wales are

going overland to Genoa, Italy, where they will embark on the British battleship *Renown*, which is due to arrive at Bombay on November 9th. They will stay in India until March, visiting the principal cities and native states and receiving the chiefs and princes on behalf of King Edward.

The departure of Lord Curzon, the viceroy, who recently resigned and who

will be succeeded by the Earl of Minto was postponed in view of the fact that King Edward desired Lord Curzon to remain in office and officially welcome the Prince and Princess of Wales.

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**WANTED FOR MURDER.**

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Remy, Alias Harmand, is Accused of Killing a Young Rancher in

Montana.

The latest development in the case of Camille Frederick Remy, alias Harmand, who is being held at Vancouver on suspicion of having murdered W. J. Oliver at Wolf Creek, Montana, on September 23rd last, was the discovery by the detectives Tuesday of a watch upon him with the initials "W. J. O.," evidently

Montana dispatches contain some details of the crime of which Remy is accused. The murdered man, Wason J. Oliver, was a rancher. 24 years of age and was the son of the county commissioner of Beaverhead county, Montana. Last spring young Oliver travelled into Alberta with a wagon and five horses and took up a ranch, and then returned

to his home in Dillon, Montana. In August he set out for Alberta again with a Frenchman whose identity was then unknown, but who is now supposed to be Remy, and who was his constant companion.

Oliver was last seen late in September about 20 miles north of Helena, and on October 8th his body was found in a shallow grave on the edge of Wolf creek. It was badly decomposed, but was identified.

fied by the clothing, and the marks seemed to show that the young man had been killed - yow a blow on the temple. Inquiry showed that on September 24th, directly after the murder, the Frenchman, known also as Harmand, had been seen driving his own wagon and pulling Oliver's behind, and later he burnt the body of Oliver's wagon and sold the four wheels to a rancher, who was able to describe the murderer to the officers. Remy was traced to Nelson by the American police.

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**CHARGED WITH CONSPIRACY.**

Indictment Returned Against Former  
Bank Presidents and Other Officials.

Denver, Col., Oct. 17.—Leonard I.

Camp, D. M. Cary, A. B. Davis and J.

Edmonson were indicted by the grand jury to-day on the charge of conspiracy in stealing \$1,712,587 from the Denver Savings bank.

Wildfire and Edmonson were former presidents of the Denver Savings bank and Hill was president of the same bank when a receiver was appointed on August 15th. H. L. Hull is president of the Mount Vernon Savings bank, of Boston; Robert and Cary are officers of the Cherokee State bank, of Enid, Okla.; Camp and Davis

In addition to the general conspiracy indictments, seven indictments were found against Edmonson on charges of larceny, embezzlement and converting the funds of the depositors to his own use. He was charged specifically with the robbery of \$105,000.

Warrants were immediately issued for the answer of the indictments. Imboden, Waffey and Hull were arrested to-day.

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
