IMPRESSIVE FUNERAL

OF MRS. F. R. DYKEMAN

Well Known Resident of Jemseg Passed Away this Week

—Was Over 88 Years of Age.

The funeral of Mrs. Francis R. Dykeman, widow of Gilbert C. Dykeman, and one of the oldest and most respected residents of Jemseg, took place on Aug. 8th, in the Dykeman cemetery.
