FRANKLIN LANE DIES SUDDENLY

Former Secretary of the Interior Under President Wilson Passes Away.

Bochester, Minn., May 18.—Franklin K. Lane, former U. S. Secretary of Interior, died at a local hospital here early this morning. Death was due to an attack of angina pectoris.

It was often said of Franklin K. Lane that if he had been born in the United States instead of Canada, he would have been presidential timber.

Upon leaving college he engaged in newspaper work, becoming part owner and editor of the Tacoma, Wash., Daily News. In 1889 he was admitted to the bar of California and from 1897 until 1902 he served as Corporation Counsel of San Francisco.

In 1916 Mr. Lane headed the American delegates at a joint conference with High Commissioners from Mexico, as a result of which a protocol was signed at Atlantic City and United States troops were withdrawn from that country.

Secretary Lane was a keen supporter of the League of Nations convention and advocated ratification of the Treaty of Versailles.
