McHeffy, Hon. Richard A.

B. in Tp. of Windsor, N.S. M. Miss Hill, of Halifax. Is Custos of Hants, and Senior Grand Warden of Freemasons, N.S. Elected Presdt. of Central Board of Agriculture, N.S. 1874. Sat for Windsor in N.S. Assembly for many years. Was called upon to form the present Administration in N.S., which duty he performed. Apptd. a mem. of Ex. Council Nov., 1867. Called to L.C., 1853. A Liberal-Windsor; Halifax; Halifax Club.

McKenna, Hon. GILBERT, J.P.
