An Act respecting the Lake Erie and Detroit River Railway Company.

WHEREAS the Lake Erie and Detroit River Railway Com- Preamble. pany has, by its petition, prayed for the passing of an Act for the purposes hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her 5 Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :---

Any Act hereafter passed for the purpose of controlling Power of railway companies incorporated by or subject to Parliament as as to future 20 to the issuing of stock or bonds, and as to rates or tolls and legislation. the regulation thereof, and as to running powers over or other rights in connection with the railway of any company by any other company, and the exercise of powers conferred upon railway companies, shall apply to the said company from the 25 time such Act goes into effect; but this section shall not be construed to imply that such Act would not apply to thesaid company without the enactment of this section.
