by the line dividing the land of Joseph Chabot from that of Pierre Edouard Leclère, Esquire; and in the rear towards the Northwest, by a line following the division line between the River Lands and those of the *Petit Rang*, commencing at the line dividing the lands of P. E. Leclère from those of Joseph Chabot, and ending 5 at the road commonly called the "Petit Rang Road;" the said line forming an angle at this point, and then following the watercourse which separates the said road from the land of the heirs of the late Jean François Tétu, Esquire, as far as the North-west side of the land of the St. Lawrence and Atlantic Railroad, and 10 from this point, following the watercourse which runs along the said railroad, crossing the Petit Rang Road to a point opposite the watercourse which separates the said road from the land of the fabrique of St. Hyacinthe; thence the said line running upwards along the latter watercourse as far as the division line of the lands 15 of the Petit Rang, and following the division line between the latter lands and those of the River, as far as the line dividing the land of the Corporation of the Seminary of St. Antoine from that of Antoine Charron dit Cabana.

Town divided into five Wards, which shall be respectively known and designated as "Ward Number One," "Ward Number Two," and so on to "Number Five," inclusively, and the said Wards shall be bounded as follows, that is to say:—

- Ward No. 1. "Ward Number One" shall be bounded in front by the River 25 Yamaska; on the North-east and in depth, by the limits of the said Town; and on the South-west by the rear line of the emplacements lying on the North-east side of Sainte Marie Street.
- Ward No. 2 "Ward Number Two" shall be bounded in front by the said River, in depth by the limits of the said Town; on the North-east 30 by "Ward Number One," and on the South-west by a line drawn through the centre of Mondor Street, and by the rear line of the emplacements situate on the South-west side of Laframboise Street.
- Ward No. 3. "Ward Number Three" shall be bounded in front by the said River; in depth by the limits of the Town; on the North-east by 35 "Ward Number Two;" and on the South-west by a line drawn through the centre of Saint Ann Street.
- Ward No. 4. "Ward Number Four" shall be bounded in front by the said River; in depth by the limits of the Town; on the North-east by "Ward Number Three;" and on the South-west by a line drawn 40 through the centre of Bourdages Street, as far as the Railroad, and uniting at that point with the line which forms the limits of the Town on the North-east of the Petit Rang Road.
