## CAP. XXI.

An Act to confirm certain Acts of the Legislature of Newfoundland respecting the rebuilding of the Town of Saint John's Newfoundland, and to enable the said Legislature to make other Provisions respecting the rebuilding of the said Town.

[24th May 1849.]

HEREAS by an Act passed in the First Year of King George the Fourth, intituled An Act to regulate the 1 G.4. c.51. rebuilding of the Town of Saint John's in Newfoundland, and for indemnifying Persons giving up Ground for that Purpose, it was enacted, that certain Streets and Cross Streets in the said Town should be respectively of the Width specified in the said Act: And whereas by an Act of the Legislature of Newfoundland passed in the Ninth and Tenth Years of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled An Act to regulate the rebuilding of the Town of 9 & 10 Vict. Saint John's, and the Drainage and Sewerage of the same, and to c.3. (Newfoundland Acts therein mentioned, and by another Act of the said Act.) Legislature of Newfoundland passed in the Tenth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled An Act to amend an Act passed 10 Vict. c. 1. in the Ninth and Tenth Years of the Reign of Her present (Newfoundland Act.)
