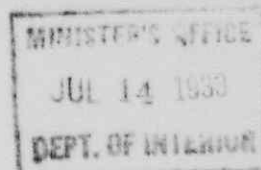

I beg to advise you that last year we employed Mr. S. E. Dafoe as Clerk, Grade 3, on the Blackfoot Reserve in connection with crop share leases. He was paid at the rate of \$115.00 a month, less 10%, from August 15th to December 15th. The employment of a Clerk, Grade 3, in this connection has been approved by the Treasury Board for the period from August 15th to September 30th, next. I write to ask whether the employment of Mr. Dafoe this season, if he is available, will meet with approval.
