Dear Sir:

I wish to ask your advise in regard to my land here on this Reserve. Some time ago I sold a part of my land to one Mitchell Sam. He agreed that on the eastern end of my land is the eastern boundary, then goes west along side the road to a certain pine tree at a corner of the fence then directly south to the International Boundary Line on which my lands border. the southern boundary being the International Line.

Now unawares to me, said Mitchell Sam brought two of the Chiefs here to the land and began measuring the land when I discovered them, and told them it was not fair nor right for them to be measuring my lands all by themselves, without telling me, as I would want my man along to see that it was done correctly. I was the one to tell them what and how much of my land I agreed to sell to Mitchell Sam.

However they made their measurements Chief Goran Jocko did the work and figured it out to contain $6\frac{7}{8}$ acres.

The two Chiefs with him Jake Fire and Joseph Sam^{then} ratified the measurements when they do not know the first thing about figuring.
