from the Lighthouse property to the shore of Rainy River, the western boundary of which road may be described as follows,— Beginning at a point on the said boundary of the Lighthouse reserve distant West astronomically fifteen chains and fifty links from the South East corner of the said Lighthouse reserve; thence South ten degrees and nine minutes West seven chains to where a post has been planted; thence South nine degrees and fifty—seven minutes East seven chains and seventy—two links to where a post has been planted; thence South thirty—eight degrees and twenty—seven minutes West eleven chains to where a post has been planted; thence South seventy—eight degrees and twenty—five minutes West four chains and sixty links, more or less, to the shore of Rainy River, containing by admeasurement three acres and five hundredths of an acre, more or less.
