Dear Sir:

I am attaching a Resolution submitted by Mr. Booth from the Pasqua Sand for the expenditure of \$210.00 to be spent as follows:

An amount of \$75.00 for the purchase of glass, stove pipes, paint, etc. to be purchased by the Agent for those Indians requiring it on the Reserve, thereby improving the condition and general appearance of their homes.

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FEGISTER

An amount of \$60.00 for the purchase of 1200 pickets. These pickets are to be sharpened and delivered to the Agency this Winter and meed next spring for the purpose of re-building the boundary fence on the east side of this Reserve.

An amount of \$82.00 to be used for wages for road work done on the Pasqua Reserve last summer. With respect to this expenditure for road work I have asked Mr. Booth to forward a voucher to you and this is forthcoming.

An amount of \$50.00 was requested by the Band to be held at the Agency Office for use by the Chief and Councillors of the Band. I have deleted this because I feel that they can do without this. The total expenditure requested, therefor is about \$160.00. I would recommend that this be approved.
