

| | 7-11-43 | | Edenvale: Flying washed in 0800 hours, washed out 1800 hours. Personnel were entertained at a dance in Collingwood. A picture was shown in the Station Theatre at 1945 hours. 0900 hours ceiling 300', visibility 1½ miles. Flying washed in 1000 hours, washed out 1730 hours. Flying time 246.30 hours. Night flying - Nil. Edenvale: Flying washed in 1330 hours, washed out 1800 hours. A Flight of airmen accompanied by the Station Band participated in a Ceremonial Parade at Cookstown under the auspices of the Cookstown Soldiers' Club. Two pictures were shown in the Theatre, one at 1800 hours and one at 2000 hours. At 2000 hours a Travelogue Movie "East of Bombay" was shown in the Recreation Centre. A party of 24 civilians from Mount Forest, Ontario, made an organized tour of the Station, arriving at 1430 hours and departing at 1800 hours.
