In view of the Superintendent General's remarks upon my Report above referred to I recently prepared a Report to him anticipatory of his return to the country, recommending that additions be made to the two Institutions for the accommodation and education of Indian girls thereat, and that provision for the construction of the buildings and for the support and tuition of female pupils be made in the Estimates next Session of Parliament. I also recommend that provision be made for the tuition and maintenance at Battleford of female Indian pupils; but, as there would be no necessity for any addition to the building there, I have merely recommended on that score that an item be inserted to provide for any necessary
