Ottawa, 20th. January, 1909.

Sir;-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 15th instant and in reply to inform you that the vendor (if not himself an Indian) of any article to an unenfranchised Indian who has not taken any lien upon the article sold by him to the Indian can only recover payment by suing the Indian before some court of competent jurisdiction.
