I beg to inform you that the Department has informed Dr. Brydon-Jack that his services will no longer be required on behalf of the pupils of the Sechelt Boarding School. In future Dr. T. A. Wilson is to be called upon when necessary to attend pupils of the school.

I transmit herewith copy of a letter which is being addressed to the Rev. Superior of the Institution, and I am sending the original of this letter to you in order that you may forward it to her. You will observe that the Superior is only to call upon the services of the Doctor in cases of a serious nature, and when he leaves Vancouver to attend at the school he is to place a physician in charge of his Indian patients from the Reserves.
