I have sent a telegram today to Mr.

Massey, asking him to use his best endeavours to facilitate Mr. Burnett's departure from the United Kingdom. I think you have a copy of the letter I sent to Hudd some weeks ago, asking the High Commissioner's Office to arrange passage priorities for Mr. Burnett and his family. This has been done on the assumption that there would be no difficulty about securing an Exit Permit. I think that Mr. Massey's intervention with the United Kingdom Exit Control authorities will fix up the matter without too much trouble. I have advised Mr. Burpee of the action I have taken.
