the final approval of the application is given.

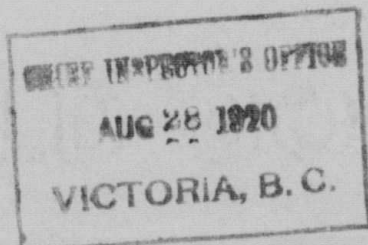
