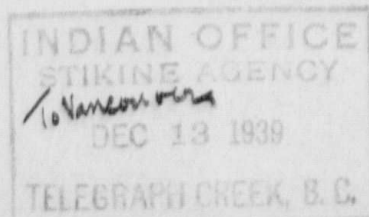
The Indian so concerned has not been in here about this matter, and as this Office knows nothing at- all about such alterations, they certainly will not be signed.
