

### JOHN N. LAKE, Esq.

**J**OHN N. LAKE, Esq., was born in Ernestown, of U. E. Loyalist stock, near Bath. Received a thorough public school education, entered the Methodist Ministry in 1855, and was sent to Picton, when the Picton circuit comprised 22 congregations, as assistant minister, was invited back for a third term but was sent west near London, in 1857. Mr. Lake retired from the ministry in 1870, owing to broken health. He settled in Toronto and is now a prosperous man of business. He was elected to the City Council in 1881, but refused a second term. Mr. Lake was early identified with the Prince Edward County Old Boys, and is now their president.
