THE CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD

REGULATIONS

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitobs or the Northwest Territories, excepting 3 and 26, which has not been home-sicaded, or reserved to provide wood lots for settlers, or for other pur-picas, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of on-culart section of 160 scres, more or less. ENTRY.

Entry may be made personally at the local land e for the District

in which the land to be taken is situate, or if the homesteader de-sives he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipeg, or the Local Agent for the District in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make entry for him. A fee entry. of \$10 is charged for a homestead

HOMESTEAD DUTIES.

HOMESTEAD DUTIES. A settler who has been granted ar entry for a homestead is required by the provisions of the Dominion Lands Act and the amendments-thereto, to perform the conditions connected therewith, under one of the following plans:--(1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years. (2) If the father (or mother to
