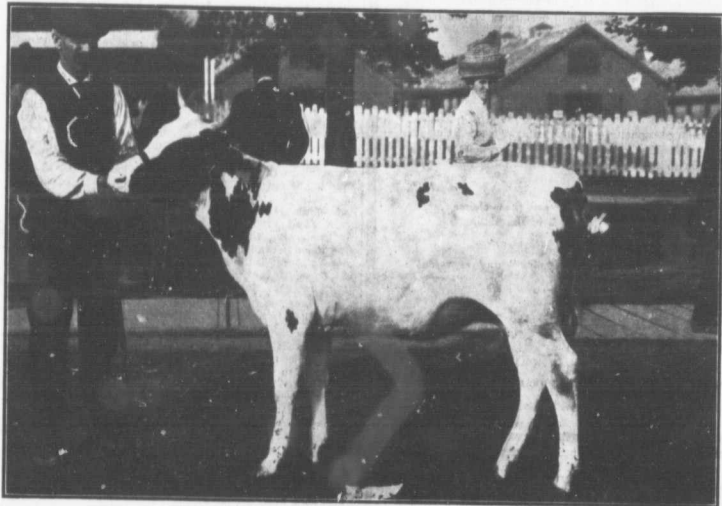

HUMSHAUGH KATE, AN AYRSHIRE HEIFER THAT IS PRACTICALLY IDEAL IN TYPE

This pure bred Ayrshire heifer, owned by A. Hume & Co., of Menie Ont., was the first prize senior heifer calf at the Canadian National Exhibition, Toronto, and with her full sister won the award offered for the best two animals the progeny of one cow. She was also a prize winner at the London Exhibition last week. This heifer is the type the expert breeders seek after. Notice her open nostril, broad forehead, strong jaw, long lean neck that blends nicely with the shoulder, her straight, strong, back, unusual length of barrel, her depth behind the shoulder and her well aprung ribs, denoting a strong constitution, and the dairy qualities of her hind quarters. Heifers like these make money for the men who own them. We need more of them. Mr. Hume may be seen holding her.
