The improvement shown in the financial position of the railway during November and December 1923 was due primarily to a reduc tion in operating expenses. 

Ottawa, Jan. 30-Two changes are announced to-night. namely Hon. Ernest Lapointe, Minister of Marine and Fisheries to be come Minister of Justice: P.J.A. Cardin, member for Richilieu, appointed Minister of Marine and Fisheries in succession to Mr. Lapointe

The appointment of Mr. Lapointe fills the vacancy caused by the re signation of Sir Lomer Gouin. Since Sir Lomer Gouin resigned! Mr. Lapointe has been Acting Minister of Justice. As Mr. Lapoints already holds a salaried Cabine position his new appointment with not entail a by-election.

Mr. Cardin's appointment will necessitate a by-election. In the last general election Mr. Cardin carried Kichilieu by a majority 2 662 and in every contest since Liberal to the Federal House.

Hon. Mr. Cardin has represente Richilieu in liament since 1911. He was born in 1879 in Sorel, Que. where he now resides. He studied law at Laval University and was admitted to the bar in 1908. He has been counsel for the city of Sorel for ten years as well as counsel all the municipal councils lichilieu county. He had been niember of the counci lof the Bar of Montreal as representative lawyers practising outside that cty. He has argued many cases in the Supreme Court of Canada, the Quebec appeal court; the railway commission and the public utilities commission.

Mr. Lapointe and Mr. Cardin were sworn in before the Governor General at Kideau hall.
