

Britain's Drink Bill

Last year the United Kingdom spent roundly \$800,000,000 on intoxicating liquors, representing about \$17.50 her head of the population, or about \$90 per family of five. As the figures include children, abstainers and only occasional users they do not indicate the money actually expended by the habitual consumers of intoxicants. The total sum is slightly less than six times the expenditure on the army, about four times that on the navy, is a half more than the railway receipts, and exceeds by \$150,000,000 the value gold. of the nation's dwellings. Contrary to the common notion England and Wales expend more on drink than either Scotland or Ireland.

Large as the total is, it is less by \$6,000,000 than that of 1901, notwithstanding the exceptional indus-trial prosperity. Both that year and 1910 disclosed a slight upward tendency, ascribed to buoyant trade, but it has apparently been more than checked by the temperance agencies. As compared with 1874 the consumption per head of beer has fallen by over six gallons, of spirits to little more than half and to wine of less than a half. Mr. George B. Wilson, secretary of the United Kingdom Alliance, from whose annual review of the trade these figures are taken, notes that by lowering the gravity of their beer the brewers passed on to the consumers very much more than the whole of the taxes levied in 1910.
