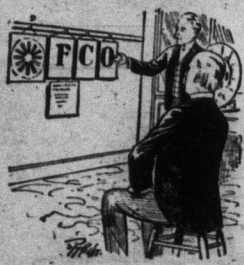

AN OUTRAGE

Town Authorities

Send Bailiff to

W. G. & R. Co's

Establishment

TO COLLECT TAXES IN DISPUTE

The town authorities made a seri-

ous blunder to-day in sending the bail-

iff down to the Williams, Greene &

Bone Co's establishment to levy on

it for the sum of \$219 tax amount

in dispute between the town and the

company.

News Record readers are familiar

with the details of the question. It

was threshed out last year by the

Council, and they decided that the

Company was exempt under their by-

law, and that in fairness to this

the biggest wage-paying firm the

town possesses, they should remain

exempt on everything, except as to

school taxes, until the expiration of

their by-law, Jan. 1st, 1903.

The people strengthened the hands

of the Council by holding a "monster

Board of Trade meeting, and voicing

their opinion of the matter. After the

Council's action, it was thought that

the incident had been closed. We do

not know who is at the bottom of

this outrage. Whoever it may be, he

is no friend of the town of Berlin, and

deserves the severest condemnation.

The people of Berlin cannot afford

to treat the W. G. & R. Co. in such a

shabby, spiteful manner.

From one end of Canada to the other,

the news will go that Berlin is a

place which repudiates its contracts

and is careless of the welfare and

good name of its largest labor em-

ploying industry.

A public meeting of citizens is to

be held to-morrow night, and it is

the duty of every intelligent citi-

zen to attend it and attest that he

condemns the bounding of this re-

putable firm. There may be a few

men, prominent in public affairs, who

do not care whether the firm is

wronged or not, but the great major-

ity of our citizens wish it to be treat-

ed fairly and well, and these must

rally and stop the high-handed, cov-

erise measures that have set afoot.

The proceedings taken to-day are

a shame and a disgrace to Berlin.
