


Parsons.

Henry, was m. and had issue, a son, whose name is not at present known, who m. Anne Crane of Bridgewater,* and had issue, probably besides others, viz. :

Henry, b. 1700, in Holy Orders, B.A. Exeter Coll., Oxon, 1722, M.A. Trinity Coll. 1729, Vicar of Bansip, Higham and Chelney; m. Elizabeth, dau. of John Michel, in H.O. (of the same family as the late Field Marshal Sir John Michel), and had issue, besides a son Henry murdered in India, and two daus., one m. to — Carr, and the other to — Axford,

Francis-Crane, b. 1731, d. 1798, in Holy Orders, B.A.

*Supposed to have been niece of Francis Crane, of Somerton Erleigh, in 1676, whose will named Andrew Parsons of Parsons Hill Trustee, and who d.s.p.
