

HARDWARE AND METALS.-A considerable movement in hardware required for seasonable use is taking place, and reduced prices are bringis taking place, and reduced prices are bring-ing out good enquiries. Through force of com-petition the price of ingot copper has been reduced to 10½ to 11c. The tariff changes have weakened the values of sheet zinc, and stocks being heavy prices are easier at 5 to 5½0. In tin plates ordinary brands of charcoal IC, IX, IXX, DC, may be had at 25c. less than quoted prices. Competition of makers, added to alterations in the tariff, have caused a fur-ther reduction in rome. ther reduction in rope.
