Resolutions adopted by the United Nations Security Council acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations (a) on the Situation in the Persian Gulf and (b) on the Embargo on All Deliveries of Weapons and Military Equipment to Yugoslavia

Done at New York, **March 2, 1991**

Entered into force for Canada March 2, 1991

Note: Decisions of the Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the United Nations Charter are binding on all members of the United Nations when passed

WAR - RULES OF WARFARE

Modification of Canada's reservations to the Protocol for the Protocol of the Use in War of Asphyxiating, Poisonous or Other Gases, and of Bacteriological Methods of Warfare, done at Geneva June 17, 1925

Done at Geneva, **September 6, 1991**

Entered into force for Canada September 6, 1991

Note: Modification to Canada's reservations to the Protocol insofar as they relate to bacteriological methods of warfare

Protocol Additional to the Geneva Conventions of 12 August 1949, and relating to the protection of Victims of International Armed Conflicts (Protocol I) (with Annexes)

Done at Geneva, **June 8, 1977**

In force September 7, 1978

Signed by Canada December 12, 1977

Ratified by Canada November 20, 1990

Entered into force for Canada May 20, 1991

Protocol Additional to the Geneva Conventions of 12 August 1949, and relating to the Protection of Victims of Non-International Armed Conflicts (Protocol II) (with Canadian Reservations and Statements of Understanding)

Done at Geneva, **June 8, 1977**

In force September 7, 1978

Signed by Canada December 12, 1977

Ratified by Canada November 20, 1990

Entered into force for Canada May 20, 1991
