

**ARRANGEMENT
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA
AND
THE EUROPEAN SPACE AGENCY
CONCERNING THE PARTICIPATION BY THE GOVERNMENT
OF CANADA IN THE EUROPEAN TRANSPORTATION
AND HUMAN EXPLORATION PREPARATORY
ACTIVITIES PROGRAMME**

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA (hereinafter referred to as “Canada”)

and

THE EUROPEAN SPACE AGENCY, established by the Convention opened for signature in Paris on 30 May 1975 (hereinafter referred to as “the Agency”),

HAVING REGARD to the *Cooperation Agreement between the Government of Canada and the European Space Agency*, done at Paris on 15 December 2010 (hereinafter referred to as the “Cooperation Agreement”), and in particular its Article III;

HAVING REGARD to the Additional Declaration on a slice of the European participation in the International Space Station Development Programme, namely the European Transportation and Human Exploration Preparatory Activities Programme, referred to as ESA/PB-HME/XVIII/Dec.1 (Final), drawn up on 26 November 2008;

HAVING REGARD to Canada’s request to participate in the European Transportation and Human Exploration Preparatory Activities Programme expressed at the meeting of the Agency’s Council held at ministerial level on 25-26 November 2008;

HAVING REGARD to Article XIV.2 of the Agency’s Convention, which relates to cooperation and participation by non-member States in the Agency’s programmes;

HAVE AGREED as follows:
