

here. At the next meeting, we may have another witness here in addition to what we have discussed this morning.

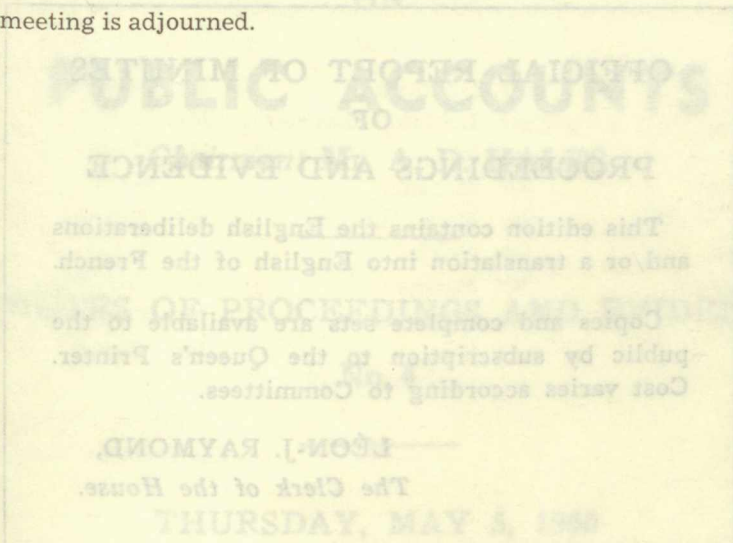
