The Honourable Senator Crerar, from the Standing Committee on Natural Resources, to whom was referred the Bill (K-11), intituled: "An Act to amend The Manitoba Natural Resources Act", reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the Senate, without any amendment.

The Honourable Senator Robertson moved that the said Bill be now read

a third time.

After debate, and—

The question being put on the said motion, It was, on division, resolved in the affirmative. The said Bill was then read the third time.

The question was put whether this Bill shall pass.

Ordered, That the Clerk do go down to the House of Commons and acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill, to which they desire their concurrence.

On motion of the Honourable Senator Hayden, it was—

Ordered, That the Parliamentary fees paid upon the Bill (E), intituled: "An Act respecting The Toronto, Hamilton and Buffalo Railway Company and Canadian National Railway Company", be refunded to The Toronto, Hamilton and Buffalo Railway Company, less printing and translation costs.

The Order of the Day being called for the second reading of the Bill (L-11), intituled: "An Act respecting Bankruptcy", it was—

Ordered, That the said Order of the Day be postponed until to-morrow.

The Order of the Day being called for resuming the adjourned debate on the motion of the Honourable Senator Robertson, seconded by the Honourable

Senator Copp—

That it is expedient that Parliament do approve the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade including the Protocol of Provisional Application thereof, attached to the Final Act of the Second Session of the Preparatory Committee of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Employment held at Geneva from April 10 to October 30, 1947, together with the complementary agreement of October 30, 1947, between Canada and the United States of America; that the Senate do approve the same, subject to the legislation required in order to give effect to the provisions thereof.

It was Ordered, That the said Order of the Day be postponed until to-morrow.

The Order of the Day being called for resuming the adjourned debate on the motion of the Honourable Senator Robertson, seconded by the Honourable Senator Copp—

That it is expedient that Parliament do approve the complementary agreement of October 30, 1947, between Canada and the United Kingdom relating to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade; and that the Senate do approve the same, subject to the legislation required in order to give effect to the provisions thereof.

It was Ordered, That the said Order of the Day be postponed until to-morrow.
