I hold Grade A diploma from the Department of Canadian Militia for the teaching of physical exercises, and at this moment I am professor of physical training at Nicolet Seminary where I have more than 300 pupils and am, moreover, instructor for the three officially recognised Cadet Corps of Nicolet.
