AMONG the various Drawings of Scenery presented to the public by modern Travellers, none have yet displayed the grand and striking objects appearing in those wild and extensive parts of North America which are situated between Upper Canada, and the coast westward of the Mackenzie River.

Nor can it excite surprise that Artists are disinclined to visit these remote regions, peopled only by thinly-scattered tribes of Indians; where person and property are insecure, and life itself is frequently exposed to danger, from want of provisions, or the extreme severity of the climate.

The work now proposed will supply this deficiency, and not only represent scenes entirely new, replete with beauty and interest, but show the many difficulties that are to be encountered in travelling over this portion of the American Continent, abounding with spacious lakes, lofty mountains, and numerous rapids and cataracts.

It is intended to publish the work in Numbers every Two Months, each containing Five Engravings, of the same size as the European Scenery, with a Topographical Description of each View. The whole will consist of Twelve Numbers, forming Two Volumes, or may be bound up with "Franklin's Narratives."

The Drawings will be engraved in the best line manner, by Mr. EDWARD FINDEN; and it is confidently hoped, that the style in which the work will be executed will merit the approbation of the public, and especially the admirers of this branch of the Arts.
