paid, and pay the same over to the Treasurer immediately, taking his receipt therefor, and report at each meeting the amount of money received, and the same shall be entered on the records. He shall furnish the Chairman of the Visiting Committee with the name and residence of every member reported sick, whether such member is entitled to benefits, and perform such other duties as may be required of him.

SEC. 7. It shall be the duty of the Investigating Committee to examine and report upon the eligibility and character of all applicants for membership, examine and audit all accounts of the Financial Secretary and Treasurer, and report quarterly, or sooner if required; examine, and if found correct, approve all bills against the Association. They shall also examine all charges submitted to them against members, and if in their opinion such charges are sustained, shall report thereon to the Association at the first regular meeting thereafter. They shall have charge of all property belonging to the Association not otherwise provided for.

SEC. 8. It shall be the duty of the Visiting Committee, on the notification of the Financial Secretary, to visit sick members, and if they are entitled to benefits, the Chairman of said Committee shall procure an order from the President, attested by the Financial Secretary, for the amount necessary, and see that it is paid, and report to
