London, Feb. 5.-At the annual points interesting to the United States were raised.

Colonel Emil Ropner, M. P., president of the organization, referring to "crimping" and "blood money" in the United States, said the Chamber earnestly hoped the British Ambassador at Washington, Lord Pauncefote, would succeed in inducing the United States to introduce legislation making "crimping" a criminal offence.


