### FROM ALL PARTS OF THE EARTH

Do Visitors Come and Register at the Parliament Buildings.

The seventh volume of a series of visitors' registers, in the parliament buildings, Toronto, has just been commenced. The last volume was begun on Sept. 3, 1902, and the last entry was made on the 4th inst. The first volume of the series was begun on Sept. 8, 1895, and completed on July 16, 1897.

During the last six months there have been visitors from all parts of the States and Canada, including Dawson City, Yukon, England is represented by the leading cities—London, Liverpool, Manchester, Birmingham, Newcastle—while the Counties of York, Surrey, Stafford, Lancashire, Lincolnshire and others are frequent. Gallant Irish and Scotch are also prominent. Scotland has Leith, Portobello, Dundee, Kilmarnock and Kilwinning, Dublin and Belfast stand for Ireland, but Tipperary is not omitted. A patriotic from Goughford is enrolled himself.

India has a lieutenant from Delhi, and Shanghai and Tongking are China towns. Barbados is another British colony. Austria has Vienna and Cuba has Havana. Most of the United States visitors appear to come from Pennsylvania.

## OPPOSE H. G. & B. TRANSFER SALT FLEET COUNCIL AGTS

Resolution Expected to Be Passed To-Day—Municipalities Must Give Their Consent.

Hamilton, June 13.—(Special).—Owing to a difference of opinion about finances, both the wardens of St. Matthew's Church have resigned. A meeting of the vestry was held this evening. James B. Cuttiss was elected people's warden, and the rector, Rev. Father Whitcombe, will announce his choice for warden next Sunday.

The first golf tournament held by the ladies of the Hamilton Golf Club opened this afternoon. There were twenty-two entries for the medal play. Thru some misunderstanding an indignation meeting was announced for this evening at St. Mary's Church of the residents along the H. G. & B. There was no meeting, but it is likely a resolution will be passed by the Saltfleet Township Council to-morrow evening. J. Rykert, solicitor for Lincoln County, has given an opinion that the H. G. & B. Company had no power to hand the road over to the G.T.R. without the consent of the municipalities thru which it runs, since the municipalities were shareholders in the company.

Nona Park was opened for the season this evening. About 1000 attended the opening.

Public School Inspector Smith received word this morning that his son, Arthur Ross, had died suddenly in Muskoka.

The plans submitted by the government architects, Messrs. D. W. Wilson, for the new drill hall, call for a three-story brick and stone building, 225 feet long by over 100 feet wide. The basement will be used as a bowling alley and shooting gallery, and the building will have a gallery around the whole interior. The second floor will be used as mess rooms and the top floor will contain a big assembly hall and practice rooms for the bands.

Chancellor Martin has given it as his opinion that Rev. Father Geoghegan, who is suing in the secular courts for \$400 a year, has no claim against the clergy trust fund of the Niagara synod. The synod will open to-morrow the "Pinneret" has given notice of motion providing that clergymen may make one annual appointment of all missionary and diocesan work, and providing that rectors may make the collections as may be most effective and convenient to themselves. Another notice of motion has been given stipulating that no lay delegate shall be allowed to take his seat in the synod, and that all assessments and obligations upon the congregation for the general purpose fund are paid.

Rev. J. M. Cornwall has accepted the call extended to him by the Victoria-avenue Baptists, and he will take charge of the church on June 13.
