#### SEE NO CHANGE OF **BUTTER REDUCTION** WHEN OLEO GOMES

Dairymen Declare Price Will, Not Come Down,

EXPECT LITTLE SALE

Local Manufacturers Say Demand Will Be Light

Commenting on the announcement of the food controller that eleomargarine would not be allowed importation into Canada so much as to have it manufactured in the country, local dairymen said that the introduction of eleo into the country would find little favor with the masses of Canadian people.

A certain element, they say, might eat eleo and derive as much satisfaction from it as from butter, but this element is represented by the foreigners of the country, who previous to coming to Canada had been accuatomed to eating eleo because it could be obtained at a lower price than butter.

"I was in the States when element as lower price than butter."

"I was in the Advertiser today. "The eleo producers experienced a great deal of trouble because of a law made prohibiting the sale of eleo as butter. This law was infringed upen time and again, the butter producers being compelled to take action against the eleo men, which involved the expenditure of hundreds of thousands of dollars in agitating against the sale of the butter substitute. "If eleo is allowed to be manufactured in Canada the manufacturers will no doubt abuse the privilege, as they did in the States. It is hard to say whether butter dealers will handle elee when it is introduced into Canada, but it is safe to say that no substantial decline in butter prices will be resultant of the move. The present price being received by the farmers for butter can be expected, for the price is not excribitant—in- fact, it is very reasonable; so if the price of butter declines the farmer will just have to discontinue making it."

No definite word regarding the manufacture of eleo in the city, or even the handling of it should it be allowed in the country, could be secured from dairymen, but it was intimated that the present dealers in hutter would also handle eleo should it become popular with the Canadian people.


