Petition That Grand Jury Investigate Charges of Gambling and Drinking Affairs.

Spokane, April 8.—Petitions asking federal grand jury investigation of statements of alleged misconduct in Washington, D. C., society circles will be circulated at once in prominent Pacific coast cities, so it is announced by H. C. Harris, chairman of a citizens committee arranging for the petitions.

This was the latest development of a furor started by newspaper articles written by Mrs. Elsiebeth G. Foulds, secretary, vice or corner Senator Foulds, of this state, now ambassador in Peru, detailing gambling and drinking episodes as every day affairs in the U. S. capital.

Pittsburgh, April 8.—Eight hundred physicians of Pittsburgh—whether they are making professional calls or playing golf—will be within reach of their patients twenty-four hours a day. The County Medical Society has established the Pittsburgh Physicians' Exchange. A central telephone exchange connects with the offices of all doctors who are members of the society. A file index will be kept at the exchange, and whenever a physician leaves his office—either on business or pleasure—it will be recorded at the exchange.
