DR. BAKER INSTALS X-RAY EQUIPMENT

An X-Ray equipment of unusual design, in which is embodied flexibility, efficiency, and safety, has recently been installed in the offices of Dr. A. T. Baker, Imperial Theatre Bldg.

The apparatus was assembled and thoroughly checked by Dr. J. W. Healey, of Davenport, Iowa, who is an acknowledged expert in roentgenology, having installed equipments in each of the States of the U. S. and practically every province of the Dominion.

Through the use of the X-Ray, Dr. Baker will be aided very materially in spinal analysis, eliminating possible errors due to lens, spinales, ankylosis, spiculous growths, and every and all osseous abnormality.

Safety to both patient and operator have been amply provided for. A heavy aluminum diaphragm is used which blocks the rays which have a tendency to blur the image, consequently sharp detail and contrast is imparted to the film.

The capacity of the apparatus in general is such that any and all radiography with its many ramifications can be done with ease and dispatch, thus rendering a service second to none in the many branches to which it may be applied.

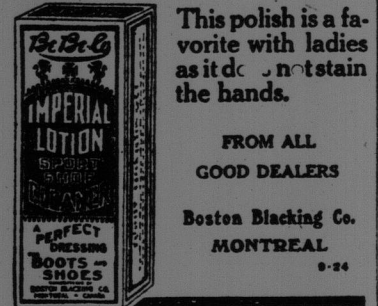

\$215,000,000 IS THE INCOME TAX TOTAL

Ottawa, May 9—Since its inception the income tax has contributed to the public treasury some \$215,000,000. Beginning with about \$9,500,000 in the fiscal year 1918-1919, it gradually increased and reached the peak of \$18,800,000 in 1921-1922.

In the fiscal year 1922-1923 it dropped to \$59,750,000. Figures for the last fiscal year are not available.
