2. Any animal or article not deemed worthy of a prize, where there is no competition, shall not be entitled to it.

3. All Grains, Seeds, Roots, and Dairy Products must be the produce of the year 1897 and raised on the ground of the exhibitor.

4. For any Agricultural Implements or Articles of Mechanical Manufacture of improved principle or superior workmanship; also for new or improved varieties of Grains, Seeds, Roots, &c., extra premiums will be awarded at the discretion of the Judges and Directors.
