of enabling the Speaker of the Houle of Assembly, for the time being, the better to maintain the dignity of his office, and to meet the expenses necessarily attendant thereon, do beseech your Majesty, that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the King's most excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the government of the Province of Quebec in North America;" " and to make further provision for the government of the faid Province:" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the Speaker of the House of Affembly, for the time being, thall, during the term of the Eighth Provincial Parliament, have an annual Salary of One Thousand Pounds, currency; payable in two half-yearly payments of five hundred pounds each, on the first day of every mouth of May and November, in each and every year, or in proportion for every period of fix months, computing from the twenty-first day of January last, during which the person exercising that office, shall have been in possession of the same; which salary shall be paid our of the unappropriated monies at the disposition of the Provincial Legistature, and the same shall be accounted for to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in such manner and form as His Majesty shall direct.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that from and after the Speaker of the Housa of Assembly disabled passing of this Act, the Speaker of the House of Assembly, for the time being, shall nce orplace of profit not hold or enjoy in his own name, or in the name of any person or persons in trust for him or his henefit, any office, or place of profit under the Crown, during pleafure.
