said County of                      shall form a provisional Municipal Council for the said County, and shall with respect to the said County, have, possess and exercise all and singular the rights, powers, privileges and duties conferred, granted or imposed by the Act passed in the 12th year of the Reign of Her Majesty, and intituled, "An Act for abolishing the Territorial Divisions of Upper Canada into districts, and for providing for temporary unions for Counties of Judicial and other purposes, and for the future dissolution of such unions as the increase of wealth and population may require," upon Provisional Municipal Councils erected by proclamation under the authority of the said Act, and also all the powers which may be conferred on Provisional Municipal Councils generally by any other Act or law in force in Upper Canada; and such Provisional Council shall and may so soon as they shall think fit so to do, purchase, or otherwise procure, the necessary property, and proceed to erect the necessary public buildings on such property; and all the provisions of the Act last above cited shall apply to the said Provisional Municipal Council and to the said County of

Public Act.

V. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
