

the powers by the said Act vested in any such Provisional Municipal Council.

A Registry Office to be kept in Wicklow when dis-united from York.

IV. And be it enacted, That when the Union of the said County of Wicklow and the County of York shall be dissolved in the manner provided by the Act aforesaid, 5  
a Registrar shall be appointed for the said County, and a Registry Office for the Registration of Deeds shall be kept in and for the same at the County Town thereof, in the same manner and under the same provisions as in other Counties in Upper Canada. 10

Commencement of this Act.

V. And be it enacted, That this Act shall have force and effect upon, from and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred fifty, and not before.
