I.—OPENING OF PARLIAMENT AND PROCEEDINGS AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF A SESSION.

- 1.—On the first day of the Meeting of a New Opening Parliament, or of any subsequent Session. His Excellency having opened the Session by a gracious Speech to both Houses and prayers being said, some Bill is read pro formâ; the Speech from The Throne is reported by the Speaker, and a Committee of Privileges, consisting of all the Senators present during the Session, is appointed.
- 2.—At the commencement of every Session, The Clerk's ac-Clerk is to lay before The Senate, on the day counts. following the appointment of the Committee on Contingent Accounts, and as often thereafter as he may require an advance of money, a detailed account of his disbursements, since the last audit, with vouchers in support thereof,
