And if any such Registrar shall neglect to appoint a Deputy Registrar as hereinbefore is prescribed, he shall forfeit five pounds current money of this Province, for each and every day during which he shall have neglected to make such appointment; which penalty shall and may be recovered in any Court of Record in Lower-Canada. and one half thereof shall go and be paid to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, and the other half thereof to the informer.
